# **Cleaning roles available at Kmart and Target stores across Melbourne.**

#### 1. What positions are available?

Permanent full-time and part-time cleaning and trolley collection roles are available at Kmart and Target stores across Melbourne.

# 2. How can I apply to work with City?

You can apply through our <u>dedicated web page</u>. From here click 'Apply Now' and choose your preferred location from the drop-down menu. Remember, when creating your profile, it's important to answer all screening questions.

#### 3. What will the job entail?

Responsibilities will include:

- Cleaning floors, staff room/kitchen, toilets, and offices.
- Operating cleaning machinery (training provided).
- Maintaining all chemicals and equipment.
- Collecting trolleys from inside and outside the store.

#### 4. What will my shift pattern be?

Each store will have a different shift pattern. This will be discussed with you during the application process.

#### 5. Will a uniform be provided?

Yes. A City uniform and appropriate PPE will be provided.

#### 6. What are the PPE standards expected of cleaners?

High visibility vest, steel cap boots, gloves (cut proof or disposable gloves). Task specific PPE includes hearing protection, eye protection and gumboots.

# 7. Will I need to undertake training?

Yes, employment with City will involve training plans for each cleaning team member. This will include City and store induction training, supervision on your first shift, machinery and equipment training, as well as training in all relevant IT systems.

#### 8. Will I need to complete a medical?

Not at this stage, however, you will be asked whether you are prepared to have a medical as part of the recruitment process and will be required to complete and submit a pre-employment declaration form.
