Cleaning Steps:

- 1. Make sure you have read, understood, and signed off the correct Safe Work Practices.
- 2. Ensure you are wearing disposable gloves.
- 3. If there's no prefilled Glance spray bottle, utilise the J-Fill Quattro Select unit to dispense Glance at the pre-configured dilution ratios into correctly labelled separate spray bottles.
- 4. Apply crème cleanser to toilet bowls and sinks, allowing to settle whist completing step 5.
- Apply Taskforce solution to the inside and outside of the toilets, including the bowl, seat, and exterior surfaces. Wipe down the exterior surfaces with a red CHUX cloth.
- 6. Use a toilet brush to scrub the toilet bowl, flushing the toilet once cleaned.
- 7. Spray Taskforce solution onto all fixtures including sinks, taps, partitions, and benches. Wipe them

- down thoroughly with blue CHUX cloth for a streakfree finish.
- 8. Spray Glance solution onto mirrors and any stainless-steel materials. Wipe them down with blue CHUX cloths.
- 9. Wipe over all window frames with a blue CHUX cloth, to remove any dust/dirt build up.
- 10. If there is any water-based paint on surfaces, spray Taskforce solution directly onto the paint and let it sit for a few minutes. Use a Blue CHUX cloth to gently remove the paint, rinsing the area with water afterward.
- 11. Inspect all surfaces for any missed spots or remaining stains. If required clean as needed with the appropriate cleaning solution and cloth.
- 12. Dispose of CHUX cloths and securely place the spray bottles in their designated areas. Ensure no chemical bottles are left in the activity rooms.





What Good Looks Like:



The Centres should be clean at the end of each evening:

- Ensuring toilet areas are clean.
- Sinks, mirrors, cubicles, and walls are clean.
- Floor area is vacuumed and i-mopped.
- Window frames are clean.

Why it's important:

- The cleanliness of the Centres are our customer's first and last impressions of our presentation, so we need to make this a positive one.
- With children moving around the centre, proper cleaning techniques can greatly reduce the risk of cross contamination and the spreading of germs and bacteria.
- Maintaining strict cleaning practices is critical to ensuring the health and safety of both Goodstart's Team Members and the children.
