
How-to Guide 11: Nappy Change Stands





Cleaning Steps:

- 1. Make sure you have read, understood, and signed off the correct Safe Work Practices.
- 2. Ensure you are wearing disposable gloves.
- Collect all necessary supplies including Diversey J512 chemical spray bottles, as well as gloves and CHUX cloths.
- If no prefilled spray bottle is available, then use the J-Fill Quattro Select unit to dispense the Diversey J512 chemical at the pre-configured dilution ratios into the correctly labelled spray bottles.
- Nappy change stands to be completed when the cleaning of the amenities task is being carried out to maximise productivity.

- 6. Spray chemical onto nappy change stands and with the blue CHUX cloth wipe nappy stands thoroughly, removing any marks and stains.
- Upon completion, ensure all chemical has been wiped with a blue CHUX cloth to ensure all chemical has been removed.
- 8. Ensure you have completed this task for all children's bathrooms and prep areas.
- 9. Dispose of CHUX cloth and securely place the spray bottles in their designated areas. Ensure no chemical bottles are left in the activity rooms.
